SUBJECT: COVID-19

Felker Brothers is continuing to monitor the COVID-19 status and recommendations from the CDC, local and national government. Recommendations from all three of these agencies include: practice good hygiene and social distancing at all times. These include:

- 1) Keep a distance of 6' feet between individuals. Social separation is crucial--next to handwashing!
- 2) Wash hands OFTEN with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer
- 3) Shield coughs and sneezes with a tissue, elbow, or shoulder (not bare hands).
- 4) Routinely clean frequently touched surfaces, such as workstations, keyboards, doorknobs, etc. Recommend using a paper towel or shirt sleeve when opening doors to avoid skin contact.
- 5) Restrict travel – travel (even between facilities) should be limited to what is absolutely necessary. Restrict outside vendors/contractors coming on-site as much as possible.
- 6) Wash hands OFTEN with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer. (This is worth repeating)

Symptoms of COVID-19 include: **fever (100.4 F or higher), coughing, and/or difficulty breathing.**
